

General Tree Information Frequently Asked Questions

- Can I trim a City tree?
Property owners may raise the clearance of a city tree up to eight feet. Anything over eight feet requires a permit. For information on permits and trimming options contact the City of Lodi Public Works Dept.
- Can I nail a sign to a City Tree?
According to the Municipal Code No. 9.08.055, "No Person shall attach any rope, wire, chain, screw, nail, bicycle lock, advertising poster, or other contrivance to any city tree, shrub or other plant."

City of Lodi New Tree Care

Basic Information

The City of Lodi recently planted (or required planting) a new tree in front of your residence or business.

These trees are the property of the City of Lodi and are easily identified because

they are normally located in the planting strip between the back of curb and the front of the sidewalk as pictured above. Other locations for City of Lodi trees include the center medians in the streets and in parks. Additional location where City trees may be planted are most of the reverse frontages. These are the areas adjacent to newer subdivisions that are generally between the back of curb and a wall. An example of this would be the

areas adjacent to Lower Sacramento Road south of Elm Street. If you have a question regarding trees, City's or Private, Please call our Tree Operation Supervisor at (209) 333-6740.



Watering

Watering the new tree in front of your property is one of the most important things you can do. Your new tree will need to be watered independently from your lawn or other ground cover. For the first year, it is recommended that you provide a minimum of fifteen (15) gallons per week. To do this, gently fill the basin around the tree to the top, let the water soak in, and then fill it for a second time. Be careful not to wash away any soil around the roots.

Help us keep Lodi green.

- We ask you to help us by taking the responsibility to water the new tree as described above.-
- String Trimmers—Damaging the Tree Bark Around the Base of the Tree Will Kill The Tree, Please use caution if using a string trimmer around any tree.
- Report any problems to the City of Lodi. This includes broken tree stakes, brown leaves on the new tree, or insect infestation.

Informacion Basica

La ciudad de Lodi recientemente planto (o requiere de plantar) un nuevo árbol frente a su residencia ó negocio. Estos árboles són de la propiedad de la ciudad y són facilmente identificados porque están normalmente localizados entre la banqueta y al borde de la banqueta, como se muestran en la fotografía de arriba. Otras locaciones de los Arboles de la Ciudad se encuentran en los pabellones de las calles ó en los parques. Locaciones adicionales donde plantaran Arboles de la Ciudad es en la mayoría de la parte trasera de las nueva extencion frontera. Estas són las areas a las nuevas subdivisiones que estan generalmente entre la parte trasera de la banqueta y la pared. Un ejemplo de estó sera las areas adyacentes a la calle Lower Sacramento al sur de la calle Elm. Si tiene alguna pregunta referente si los arboles pertenecen a la ciudad o privados favor de contactarse al supervisor de Tree Operation.

Regando

Regar los nuevos árboles frente a su propiedad es posible lo mas importante que pueda hacer. Su nuevo árbol debera ser regado independientemente de su yarda. El primer año, se recomienda que por lo menos le ponga 15 galones de agua semanalmente. Para lograr esto llene de agua la cuenca del árbol, deje que la agua se absorba y llenelo una segunda vez. Tenga cuidado de no quitar la tierra alrededor de la raíz.

Ayudenos a mantener Lodi verde

Le pedimos nos ayude tomando la responsabilidad en regar los nuevos árboles como lo describimos anteriormente.

Podadora de cordon--Dañando la corteza del árbol matara el árbol, favor de tener cuidado si usa una podadora de cordon.

Reporte cualquier problema a la ciudad de Lodi. Esto incluye las estacas quebradas que detienen los nuevos árboles, hojas cafes en los nuevos árboles o cualquier plaga
